SUBJECT: Photographing of Students

Taking pictures of school pupils and buildings for commercial purposes is normally prohibited. Any exceptions require an application in writing and the approval of the County Office of Education.

1. "Commercial purposes" in this context is defined to mean:
 - a. for sale, whether at a profit or not; or
 - b. for use in connection with the advertisement or promotion of goods or services.
2. "School pupil" in this context means boys and girls enrolled in a school/program during that part of the day they are at school, on the school grounds, or engaged in any activity under the direction and supervision of the school.
3. Photographs of any students under 18 years of age may not be taken without prior written consent of the parent or guardian.
4. All students, including adults, must have signed authorizations to photograph before publication of the photograph is issued.
5. The term "photograph" includes videotape and other visual replications.
