PREREQUISITE CREDENTIAL

Candidates must hold a prerequisite credential or be recommended for a prerequisite credential simultaneously. The prerequisite credential must include an English Learner authorization or the candidate must be eligible for an English Learner authorization pursuant to the provisions of Education Code section 44253.4(b)(1), and 5 California Code of Regulations (CCR) sections 80015.1(a)(1) and 80015.2.

LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT

Pass CSET 147 Spanish Subtest III

- CSET 147 can be waived with:
 - » A major in Spanish.
 - » Valid Single Subject Spanish teaching credential.
 - » Earning these simultaneously to the BILA.
 - » Pass program-specific interview in Spanish.
