**BYLAWS OF THE BOARD**

**SUBJECT: Governance**

The County Board of Education has the power to establish its own procedures of governance within the parameters of law.

The formulation and adoption of written Board policies shall constitute the basic method by which the Board shall exercise its leadership in the governance of the County Office of Education.

**Methods of Operation**

The County Board of Education shall concern itself primarily with broad questions of policy. The application of policies is an administrative task to be performed by the Superintendent and the Superintendent's staff, who shall be held responsible for the effective administration and supervision of the entire organization.

All actions of the Board shall be taken in official Board meetings called, scheduled and conducted according to these bylaws and the statutes of the state.
