Board Policy 3320 Claims and Actions Against the Riverside County Office of Education

BUSINESS AND GENERAL SUPPORT SERVICES

SUJECT: Claims and Actions Against the Riverside County Office of Education

Any and all claims for money or damages against the Riverside County Office of Education or the Riverside County Board of Education shall be presented to and acted upon in accordance with Board policy 3320 and administrative regulation 3320, which have been adopted pursuant to Government Code Section 935.

Compliance with this policy and accompanying administrative regulation is a prerequisite to any court action, including specifically those claims that would be excluded from the required time limit under Government Code Section 905, unless the claim is governed by statutes or regulations which expressly free the claimant from the obligation to comply with Board policies and Riverside County Office of Education procedures and the claims procedures set forth in the Government Code.

This policy is effective immediately and applies retroactively to any existing causes of action and/or claims for money and/or damages which accrued prior to the enactment of this policy.

Roster of Public Agencies

The Superintendent or designee shall file the information required for the Roster of Public Agencies with the Secretary of State and the County Clerk. Any changes to such information shall be filed within 10 days after the change in facts. (Government Code 53051)

This information shall include the name of the Riverside County Office of Education, the mailing address of the Board, and the names and addresses of the Board presiding officer, the Board clerk or secretary, if any, and other members of the Board. (Government Code 53051)
