

## **STUDENTS**

### **SUBJECT: Exemptions from Attendance**

The County Superintendent of Schools may grant exemptions from compulsory attendance to students as allowed by law and in the best interest of the student. Parents/guardians of students granted exemptions shall not incur penalties for violations of the compulsory attendance laws.

Exemptions shall not be used to remove students who are disciplinary problems. Suspension, expulsion, transfer to alternative programs and other administrative measures shall be used with these students.
