Board Policy 4118 Dismissal/Suspension/Disciplinary Action

PERSONNEL – CERTIFICATED PERSONNEL

SUBJECT: Dismissal/Suspension/Disciplinary Action

The Riverside County Board of Education (County Board) and County Superintendent of Schools (County Superintendent) desire that employees understand what is considered unacceptable conduct. Any violation of policy or administrative regulations shall be subject to disciplinary action. The County Superintendent or designee may take disciplinary action as he/she deems appropriate in light of the particular facts and circumstances involved. He/she shall ensure that disciplinary actions are taken in a consistent, nondiscriminatory manner and are appropriately documented. (cf. 1312.1 - Complaints Concerning County Office of Education)

Disciplinary action shall be based on the particular facts and circumstances involved and the severity of the conduct or performance.
